

Reflections

Thoughts For Transformation Rev. LeRoy Zemke

One of man's deepest purposes in living is to discover how he can raise his level of thinking. As this occurs, he uncovers his underlying greatness and thus demonstrates the profound connection he has to the very Source of All Life which is at his center, his very core.

Spiritual practices across the centuries demonstrate over and over and over that the entire range of beliefs we each hold are capable of change. When we permit ourselves to change even in the most insignificant of matters, we see subtle even measurably shifts, like rays of light that appear to illumine our life, our experience and that which we call reality (the actual appearance of our life).

The issue, I suspect, is the belief in duality in the world of form, the terrestrial world, of which we are a vital inseparable part. We say that life reflects good and bad, right or wrong, black or white, and a host of other similar interpretations.

A belief is nothing more, nothing less than an idea held in our thoughts which we repeat to ourselves countless times in differing ways over again and again and again! We internally interpret the belief we hold as a basic kind of reality, truth or way things are.

Some examples follows. "Life is hard, unfair, unjust, difficult or painful, purposeless, pointless." If we have an experience with a family member, loved one or friend, in which our involvement becomes difficult, we *interpret* the experience as unfair, unsatisfying, negative or even cruel, hurtful, etc..

Research shows the beliefs we have (within ourselves) *influences our interpretation* of what happens between ourselves and another person whether a family member, friend, acquaintance or other person or group of persons.

We can just as easily say, "Life is fair, just, kind, generous" and reflects positive experiences toward us if we deeply believe that life is fair, mankind is basically good, and all our experiences are interpreted as positive and in a larger sense supportive of us.

At deeper levels of our very soul, I am certain that there are increasingly subtle layers of awareness, subtle discernments or dichotomies, multiple beliefs of goodness (or less good). We are connected to cultural perspectives, religious views, family or traditional interpretations of life and a host of societal influences regionally, ethnically influenced, (language based) and many, many others. All of these affect our perceptions and color our beliefs. So, indeed, there are many many shades of light and shadow and everything in between that can and do color our very basic and very personal beliefs.

One real task, I suspect, is to examine our most basic assumptions about ourselves.

We can ask ourselves: Do I believe in a basically friendly universe? Do I believe in good vs evil? Do I believe in a God? If so, why? If not, why? Do I believe in the ability I have to maintain good health, or to earn a good, perhaps maybe even excellent living (income, etc.)

Because our beliefs are multilevel, multilayered, they are often not very conscious. We say for example, "I am open to meet work with, even develop friendship with a person of another race, creed or faith <u>based</u> conviction." Yet when we actually meet and have the opportunity to interact with a person of a different race or culture, faith, educational status or financial background, we may discover some real inequalities...in what we say and how we interpret our interaction with that person.

In more metaphysical terms we often see many opportunities to create a new and positive future. Yet, given the specific circumstances thrust upon us, are we really deeply willing to be open and receptive to create the unknown future, by changing our beliefs?

All the emerging scientific research and social psychology of contemporary times speak to a major conclusion: the so-called Presence of God (our inner power)...is equally available to all beings whether or not we believe in that power/presence. If that power gives us life, then it forms the very basic connection, the "cosmic soup" so to speak, we have to our beliefs! While we can point to particular beliefs espoused by our parents, grandparents, siblings or family or whoever serves as family, the larger truth or discovery is that our beliefs about life are our own. We each uniquely and individually ensoul them. They are uniquely ours.

To actually change our future, thus means that we must be willing to examine the very essential beliefs we hold about our own deeply held convictions. When and as we begin to change some attitude or examine a conflicting feeling about or within ourselves, our change affects others, family, friends and those around us.

The key to such change is internal willingness to be open to our life, to say, "God's will be done." We can dislike our neighbor(s), partners, friends, or the people we work with or even associate for all manner of reasons. But if we are deeply willing to say "I am ready and willing to see a situation or my

environment differently", subtle, often lesser and major changes can and do happen.

Sometimes the changes are very simple, sometimes very complex. If we demand that others change first, then we become trapped by our attitude and belief.

Such beliefs and interpretations lead to the experience of victimhood, separation from our good and the perception that others are unjust, unfair, unkind and we step into the belief of limitation and restriction. Remember our beliefs about everything are up to us! We choose what to believe and accept as valid, thus we act accordingly.

The actual dynamics of change have become the language of all manner of professional trainers, and motivational speakers in the market place as well as the stock in trade of professional therapists and counselors of every hue, shape and persuasion across the world. The work of seeing ourselves in a new light, in a fresh view, renewed and realigned to a greater vision or purpose requires time, a concerted and focused, genuine effort and a deep desire to surrender an "old" or no longer useful, relevant or accurate view of ourselves.

The following "formula" may be of value as we find ourselves willing, ready and able to change some of our beliefs so that, indeed, our future may be better, improved or altered!

- 1. <u>Decide on a specific belief you hold now that you are clearly, deeply ready to release, surrender and/or change.</u>
- 2. Write out the belief you wish to change: write it out ... in longhand! Use a computer, if necessary. Writing it out is actually better because of it's imprint on the brain and memory.
- 3. Write out the new belief you wish to embrace also in longhand. The longhand effort makes a singular important imprint on the human brain, and supports the new idea/belief.
- 4. <u>Say/affirm</u> to yourself out loud the new idea/concept you wish to embrace. For example., "I am prosperous. "I am well, whole, strong." "I am successful in my relationship with (name) in new and creative ways." I am willing to do my part to resolve all the negative emotions and conflict in my life. I am willing to forgive myself for my decision (name decision)." "I am open to a clear, new direction that supports me, my spouse, sibling, son, daughter, parent, boss (name of specific person)."
- 5. Do this once a day at a time you decide is relaxed, stress free and available to you for about 5 minutes for one month!!
- 6, Give thanks to the Source of Life always. Can be a prayer ... can be an affirmation. Can be a ritual, mantra, etc. The purpose is to allow ourselves to <u>feel</u> the connection we always have to the Source of All Life in all ways.

Remember; while we may expect those around us, indeed, the family members or the community or anyone outside yourself to change, real change is an inside job. We must change from the inside; then it becomes our own. We move forward with confidence and vision for the future.




