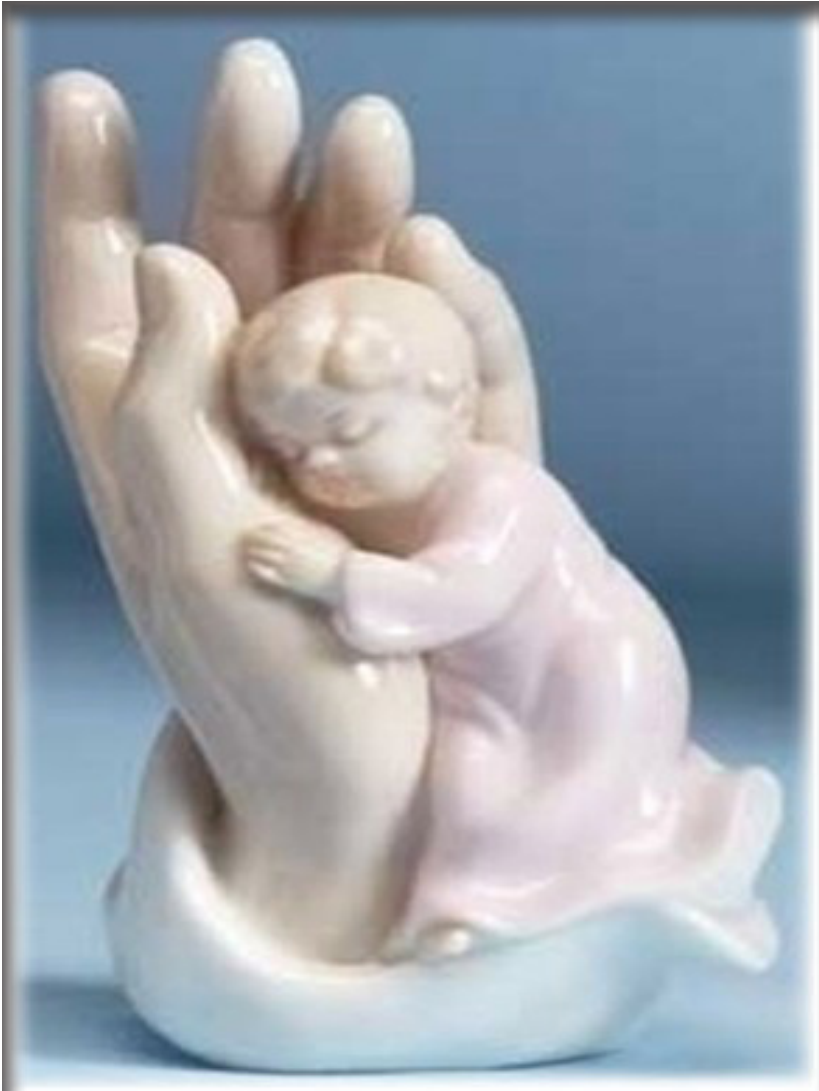

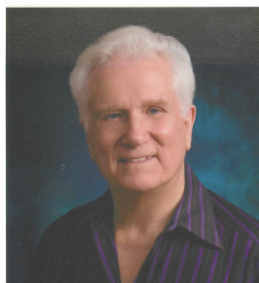

Living in the Hand of the Divine

The major goal of life can be stated this way: live each moment to its fullest potential. To do so means we will have no regret of past actions and no fear of the future.

To live life fully suggests a deepening awareness of our personal self in such areas as health, security, family, society, world community and the many inner dimensions of our being (emotional, mental, spiritual). To do this means that each of us must gradually come to terms with the way, the form and the process in which we ultimately live life - individually and collectively.

The way we live our life *is expressed* through our personal lifestyle - single or married, householder or renter, artist or factory worker; i.e. our choices for work, business or professional expression. It includes our creative outlets, sexual preferences, our life partner or spouse, friends, our involvements with religious, cultural, social or political activities, to name but a few. The path of our life is capable of being altered when we discover that a better way and other choices are open to us. When we become open to new ways or choices we actually access a new set of possibilities in our life. Essentially, the way of our life is the avenue through which we express our uniqueness, our individuality, our worldly identity.

The form of our life involves the specific patterns we individually use to express ourselves. A pattern is a specialized frame or internal picture held in our mind; it is a set of plans we have that establishes a specific purpose or direction. The form is created by choice. For example, "I want to get married!" or "I desire to go to school." We then begin to organize our thoughts, ideas, feelings and actions into an internally held image or picture as a set or grouping of plans that helps to focus our efforts. When we organize our ideas in any specific way, usually in the form of steps or plans, we are creating the pattern. If we plan to take a trip or return to school for instance, all of the thoughts, images and concepts that are directed into specific steps are part of the pattern.

When we examine the process of our life, we actually consider the individualized activities, the *combined patterns* that create the whole. If we are building a house, we scrutinize the entire project - from inception, to idea, to acquisition of the land, hiring an architect, then a contractor, having it built, then furnishing it and finally to moving in and getting settled. The process of our lives occurs in the day by day, moment by moment, dealing with the issues, the problems, and handling the solution. We can call this the “nitty gritty” of our personal life involvement.

In examining the process of our lives we must make a conscious effort not to get caught up in the activities of the past. Reflection, analysis and evaluation of our personal past can be insightful and useful. Dwelling upon it excessively or compulsively indicates a conflict which may need healing or releasing so that we can move on.

In a similar manner, we must not live in the uncharted future. We can think about it, plan (create) and actually move toward it. To attempt to really live in the future however - eagerly anticipating our next holiday, special event, romantic encounter or vacation period - robs us of precious focus and accomplishment in actually living in the present moment. Then the now moment is never really valued. It may be perceived as boring, unimportant, non-useful and non-productive. Unfortunately, we then experience the present moment(s) of our lives as something to be endured and tolerated.

Living in the Hand of the Divine is *first*, a recognition that God, as the Ultimate Source of our life, is at the center of our life. That means many things - we are not alone, we are not alienated or separate any longer. Wherever we are, God is. Whatever is occurring, God is there at the heart of it, at the very core of it. That knowledge is incredibly reassuring, affirming and clarifying. Then, we can go forward with hope, faith, trust and confidence to whatever our next step might be!

Next, living in the Hand of the Divine is a conscious cooperation and partnership with God. A conscious partnership with Source means we actively invite God into our lives. How do we accomplish this? Through prayer, through meditation, through becoming still (silent) and learning how to listen to the Inner Voice. It can occur as we plan our daily activity - asking God to bless our efforts and endeavors. It can occur if we seek assistance in any area or arena of life. We must become open, receptive and allowing of God’s presence in and through our process (or pattern), our form of living. Next we must follow the inner prompting, guidance, help or nudging that may come. With God as a partner, we can move mountains - we can achieve enormous results. We can climb any mountain (or obstacle) and reach undreamed of heights. As we become consciously cooperative with God, we experience flow instead of blockage, health instead of hurt, abundance in place of limitation.

Finally, as we learn to live in the Hand of the Divine we achieve our major goal(s)! When we can live each moment to its fullest, we

have arrived to claim one of life's most precious gifts. Life's goals vary with each of us. For some, it may be a successful career, business or completed project. For others, it may include a meaningful and deeply fulfilling relationship, or the raising of a family. For others it may involve extensive travel to foreign ports, or to man a spacecraft, walk upon the ocean floor, or found a church or school or educational institute. It may involve serving the poor, the needy, the indigent, or making the next important scientific breakthrough to cure an illness, heal the sick, or help to save the ecosystem of our planet.

In each of these areas mentioned, as well as in all potential goals, we experience an inner connection with Source that empowers and supports us in achieving our deepest and highest yearnings. When we live out of our potential we experience our connection to all areas of our life and to the life we live on this planet. We now see more clearly who we really are and recognize our unique opportunity to be on the earth. Our potential is also spiritual awareness, inner growth, and liberation from all that binds or restricts us. Thus we can move freely in our lives with confidence, consistence and commitment.

For each of us then, to live in the Hand of the Divine implies a connecting with our life circumstances. We can look at other people, but we cannot live vicariously through them. Our greatest potential cannot be developed if we are forever looking backward at the past or gazing longingly into the future. Our potential can unfold like the delicate petals of the rose, as we tend the garden, fertilize and water the plant, and allow the life force to do the rest. To have roses, we must plant roses and be responsible for their care. To have fulfillment, we must plant useful ideas, patterns and goals and tend to them dutifully and consistently. Their flowering (maturing) is in God's Hands, even as are all things in life. Such is the nature, the manner, and the way of Living in the Hand of the Divine.
